

CBSE International Life Skills, Values, Gender, School Health & Wellbeing Summit 2013

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1. What should be the age group of the student participants?

Ans. Preferably students from 9th to 12th class can participate in the Summit. All the four students can be either from the same or different classes.

Q2. Can one student participate in multiple competitions?

Ans. Yes, one student can participate in multiple competitions. No additional students (beyond the four registered students) would be allowed as accompanists or for helping with props etc.

Q3. Where should I send the registration fee?

Ans. Schools are supposed to courier the DD along with the duly filled registration form (to be downloaded from CBSE / Expressions India website) on the address given below on or before 15th September' 13:

Q4. Is the registration amount for 2 days or 4 days?

Ans. The International summit has been divided into two parts, i.e. 2 days at the Regional Summit Centre (September – November) and 2 days at New Delhi (2nd Week of December). The registration amount is for all four days.

Q5. Can I attend only the International Summit at Delhi?

Ans. Only schools registered for the Regional Summit are eligible for the International Summit at New Delhi in December 2103.

Q6. What is the staying arrangement?

Ans. Boarding and lodging at the Regional as well at the International Summit in New Delhi has to be arranged by the participating school on their own.

Q7. What is the role of accompanying teacher?

Ans. Only one teacher/ counselor is allowed to accompany the four students participating from the school. His/ her role is important for the Health Exhibition as well as for the guidance and support for the participating students in various events.

Q8. Can we change the group of students and teacher coming to International Summit in New Delhi?

Ans. No, it is strongly advised to continue with the same group of students and teacher so that they can benefit from the in-depth exposure at both the levels.
