ROUND 2

TIGER WARRIOR CAMP

Round Two, which is the Tiger Warrior Camp will be at Ranthambhore National Park, Rajasthan.

- **It will be a 3D/2N camp from June 21 till June 23, 2013.** Saevus will have its four regional coordinators to accompany the students to Ranthambhore. The regional centres will be stationed at Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Bangalore for the students coming from North, West, East and south respectively. The parents/guardians of students are expected to drop the students with the regional coordinators in time so as to reach Ranthambhore by 12 noon on June 21.
- In Ranthambhore, the students will be taken on safaris and forest visits besides various other activities. The students will be judged on various skillsets during this trip. These contests will be on-the-spot and the topics will be disclosed only at the venue.
- The winners will be announced in a function on the morning of June 23.
- The students will depart from Ranthambhore on June 23 by noon and will be accompanied by the regional coordinators till the regional centre. Parents/guardians will need to pick up the students from these centres on the prescribed date and time.
- All expenses for the students including travel (ex- regional centre), food, accommodation and safari will be borne by us.
- **The students will be accompanied by a few teachers/ volunteers from CBSE.**
